Somerset Waste Partnership offers local community groups free loan of display items (subject to availability) and promotional resources to support the national Love Food Hate Waste campaign.

## Display board, table cloth and aprons

A ready-made display "eat well for less" is available or you can borrow a display board and create your own.

Give your display a professional look with branded table cloths - range of sizes offered.

Branded aprons are eye-catching and great for busy events to help identify you from the crowd.



## Pull up banners

Suitable for indoor and outdoor events (in sheltered conditions).

Banner display system uses water-filled base for stability. Easily setup by one person.

Alternatively, can be tied to fencing or railings from corner eyelets.



## Very large (A0 size) posters

These very large posters are coated and suitable for indoor and outdoor events. Easily attached to fencing or railings using reinforced eyelet in each corner. Alternatively use Velcro strip or similar (not provided) to attach to large display boards.

These posters are too heavy to display using Blu-tac or similar.



## Long banners

We have four sizes of landscape weatherproof banners with eyelets, including two gazebo banners. Two designs can be attached to our display table: Fruit Lovers think green (180cm) and Food Lovers save money (120cm).

## Small posters (A3 and A4 sized)

A range of professionally printed posters suitable for notice boards or mini-displays.

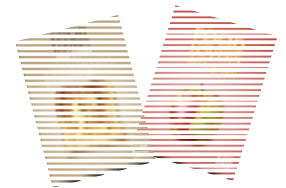
Small quantities of other poster artwork can be colour-printed on request.

- Quick quizzes: Great ice-breakers. Multi-choice quiz with answers on the back
- Guess the portion size: display portion sizes of rice and spaghetti with answer cards.
- Is it safe to eat?: Card game which tests understanding of date label and storage advice
- Savvy storage: card game about the what's best kept in the fridge or the store cupboard.
- Information sheets and handouts: These are available for a variety of related themes.
